Wildwood Garden

Wildwood fabric collection by Erin McMorris for FreeSpirit.

Quilt by Mimi Shimp.

Approximate size: 60" x 57"



Materials Needed

1/6 yard each of 36 fabrics from Wildwood collection. (If using less fabrics this quilt requires a total of 6 yards.)

Binding 1/2 yard

Backing 31/2 yards

Acrylic Ruler, mat, rotary cutter, sewing machine, scissors, template plastic, Sharpie

Optional (But highly recommended): Darlene Zimmerman's Hexagon template from EZ Quilting by Wrights

Cutting and Piecing Directions

- 1. Trace template to template plastic and cut out.
- 2. From each fabric cut 1 strip 51/2" x WOF. Using cut

template or Hexagon from EZ Quilting, cut 6 hexagons from each strip.



 Randomly stitch pairs of hexagons together as shown. Begin and end stitching ½" in from edge. Make 33 pairs.



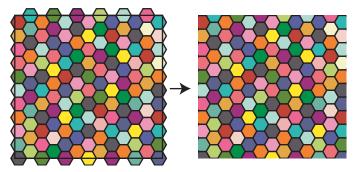
4. Lay out pairs on design wall or floor to achieve color balance. Stitch pairs together into rows. Add 1 hexagon at the end of each row. Begin and end stitching 1/4" in from edge.



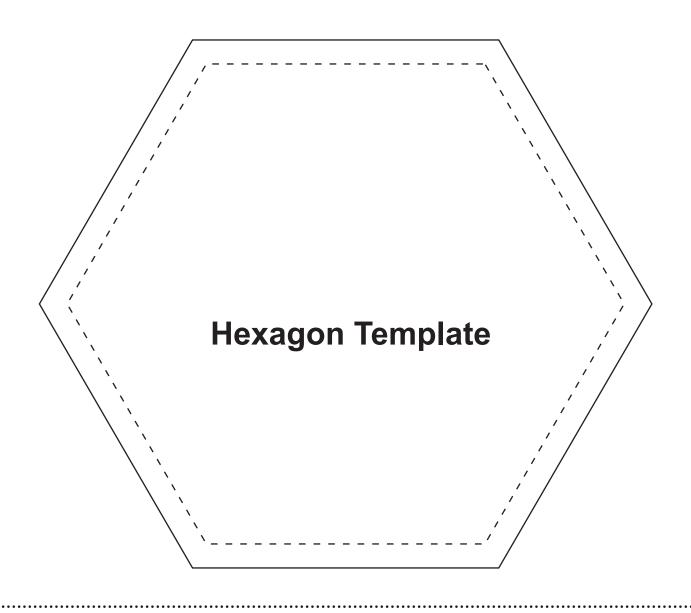
5. Stitch rows together following the diagram below, pivoting at each intersection.



6. "Square" quilt as shown using a long ruler and rotary cutterbefore adding binding.



7. Layer, quilt and bind. Cut binding strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Stitch together with diagonal seams to get one continuous strip of binding.
